

COOKIE POLICY

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies?

We use cookies on our website to manage sessions, provide personalized web pages, adjust advertising and other content to reflect your specific needs and interests in order to generally improve your user experience. Cookies can also be used to compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use the site and help us to improve the structure and its content. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies allow the website to record information about choices you have made such as username, language or region to provide improved and personalized features. They are generally used to remember the preferences you set on the website. They can also be used to provide services requested by the user, such as viewing videos or using social media. The information collected by these cookies can be made anonymous and cannot watch the activity of browsing other websites. If you do not allow these cookies, the performance and functionality of the site and your access to services may be affected.

Performance cookies

These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use the website, for example, what pages they visit most and if they get error messages. The cookies collect aggregated information anonymously that does not identify the visitor. They are used exclusively to compile reports and to help us improve the performance of our website. This information is only used to help us improve our website experience, fix issues on the site quickly and make the site easier to use.

How to control / delete cookies through a browser

You can control and/or delete cookies through the browser you use. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
